This week we welcomed Ms Romero, our new Spanish tutor. Ms Romero has settled into life at Bonneville very well, getting to know the children and staff.

As I have previously mentioned, our behaviour policy is currently under review. The document has already gone through consultation with staff and is currently under review with Governors. Next week, our School Council will consult on the policy followed by two week consultation with Parents and Carers, from Monday 23rd May to Friday 3rd June. Please look out for further details on how you can be involved in this process.

Too many parents are still waiting around on school premises after school. Unfortunately, this has led to school premises and equipment being damaged as parents are not adequately monitoring the behaviour of their children. As previously stated, we now use most of our large areas for clubs and still have large numbers of children under our care engaging in clubs on a daily basis. This means our safeguarding processes must still be adhered to during this time of the day, just as we wouldn't allow parents/Carers to wander around the building during the school day. In order to have a clear view of the adults on site and for clubs to continue un-interrupted, we desperately need your support in this matter. As safeguarding is our priority, please ensure you follow the official opening and closing times of the gate and that you are off the school premises within these times.

End of Key Stage Assessments

The testing arrangements have been changed for this year. This year it will be reported whether children have met the 'expected standard' in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science subject areas, or are 'working towards the expected standard' or 'working at a greater depth within the expected standard' for Reading, Writing and Maths. (This replaces the level system that was used previously). The results showing whether or not your child has reached the expected standard for their year group will be reported to you in your child's end of year report. The school reports the scores for each child to the Local Authority so that they can be compared nationally. In addition to this, Bonneville Primary School was one of the schools selected by the Department for Education (DFE) to carry out the English grammar, punctuation and spelling SATs in April for KS1, earlier than most schools in the country. This will enable the Standards and Testing Agency to gather the results from the pilot schools in order to ascertain the expected standard Nationally. The children have been working hard, as usual, in all areas of the curriculum and as a group have made excellent progress. Teacher assessments will still be made in May, alongside the other subjects, and can be updated from the original test results if a child has made particular progress between the assessments.

We look forward to sharing your child's achievements with you when we publish school reports on 15th July.
