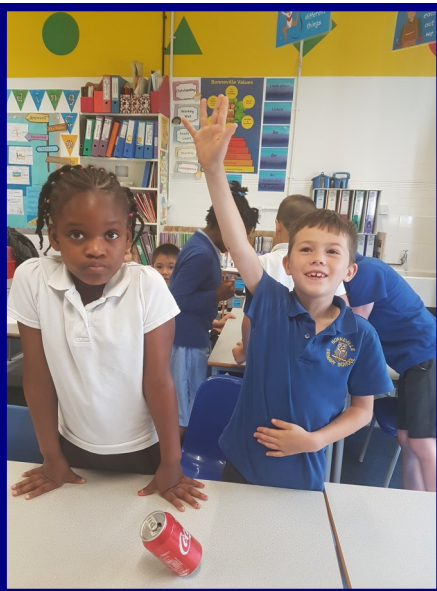
Thank you Miss Mitchell for another fantastic Science Week. You have certainly made the whole school buzz about science.
