Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our science topic of “Life on Earth” this year we have organised an educational visit to the London Wetland Centre in Barnes. The site offers 100 acres of wild wetlands, with ponds, pools and marshes. There is the opportunity to visit ‘World Wetlands’ and also use the interactive discovery centre. Children will be able to go on nature trails, explore the different habitats and the wildlife that lives there, watch birds from the multi storey hides and will also take part in a pond dipping session organised by Wetland’s own educational staff. A risk assessment has been carried out by Bonneville and Wetland centre staff, with health and safety issues considered.

The trip will take place on Thursday 13th July. The coaches will depart from school at 9.20 a.m. and return by about 3.00 p.m. Please make sure that your child wears suitable clothes, i.e. sensible shoes for walking and a waterproof jacket if there is a possibility of rain.

The total cost of this visit is £10, which should be given to class teachers by **Friday 7th July** together with the signed permission form below. If you are able to accompany us on this trip, please also indicate this on the reply slip.

This has been a busy year for all Year 2 pupils and, as well as being educational, we know that this trip will be a lot of fun!
