- Using a wide range of art and design techniques such as colour, pattern, texture, line, shapes, form and space.

As Geographers we will be...

- Examining our local area and using maps to identify the UK and its countries.
- Using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the UK and its countries.
- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West)

As Musicians we will be...

- Using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Learning a class song about the importance of being unique.
- Experimenting with and creating and combining sounds using pitch.
