As people concerned with the environment, we will explore the changes that have taken place and how we have adapted and we can protect its future.

This topic explores changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. It looks at the origin of society and culture as we know it. Children will understand the history and the geography of these times and research these through a variety of mediums including art and design, design technology and ICT.

As Scientists we will be...

Learning about Rocks through exploration and investigations:

- Comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.
- Describing in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock.
- Recognising that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

As Artists we will be...

- Exploring artwork from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age.
- Creating our own cave drawings and artwork from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages.
- Improving our skills and techniques in sculpture using a range of materials to create historical artefacts.

As Geographers we will be...

Locating the world's countries using maps to focus on Europe concentrating on their:

- environmental regions,
- key physical characteristics,
- major cities.

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As Musicians we will be...

Learning about the language of music through playing musical instruments.

We will focus on exploring and developing playing skills.

As Computers we will be...

- Using technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognising acceptable and unacceptable behaviour.
- Understanding the opportunities that computer networks offer for communication and collaboration.
- Selecting, using and combining a variety of software on a range of devices to present data and information.
- Sending emails to a book character/ author to find out more. We will also include attachments in the emails and download these.

As Historians we will be...

Exploring and finding out about the changes in Britain from the Stone Age through the Bronze Age and into the Iron Age.
