Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 6 Activity Days

I am very excited to announce that we have organised a series of activity days for Year 6 during the summer term, after the children's end of KS2 tests. The activity days will take place weekly, with the children attending one trip each week. While there may be some occasions when the children return to school slightly later than normal to maximise the amount of time at a particular location, in most instances, they will return at the end of the school day as usual.

The children will be taking part in:

- A visit to Chessington World of Adventures
- A day at Clip n Climb
- A immersive theatre experience
- A skateboarding day
- A trip to Kidzania

There will be further details about dates, times and lunch arrangements nearer the time.

The full cost of the trips will be £65. A reduced price of £32.50 can be offered

to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than $\pounds 16,190.00$)
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit;
- an income related employment and support allowance



If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to see Shobnom Wahid or Marilyn Assan in the school office.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to see Shobnom Wahid or Marilyn Assan as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties.

In order to reserve your child's place on these activity days we now require a deposit of £20 per child (£10 if you believe that you qualify for the reduced rate and are going to supply documentation to this effect). This should be paid to the school office by Friday 23rd March. You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. The total cost will be due on Monday 21st May.

Please note that although this is a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, if an insufficient number of parents make payments, the trip will not be able to go ahead. There will be
