Dear Parents and Carers,

An exciting opportunity has arisen and we have the chance to take part in a wonderful project on mystery writing with a theatre group in the West End. As spaces on the project were limited, we have been offered places for 30 of the children. These pupils will take part in a series of workshops as they learn about play writing and work in small groups to create scenes for their own mystery play. They will then be invited to return to the theatre to their work performed on stage, along with their families.

However, given that visiting the theatre is a rare opportunity, we wanted to ensure that <u>all</u> of the children were given this chance. This being the case, we are taking the entire year group to the theatre to see the play. Although all of the children may not be involved in the project, the theatre trip, and the performance, will form the basis of some of the children's learning in English, so we do not want any child left behind.

The children will visit the theatre on **Thursday 7th June**. We will be leaving school at 1:30pm. As we will be watching a matinee of a professional production, we will not return to school until 6:30pm, when all children can be collected from school.


The children will have lunch at school as usual and will not need any further food or money for the trip. However, they may wish to bring along water bottles in order to stay hydrated during the performance.

As you may be aware, tickets to a West End show can be expensive, starting at £19.50 and rising to above £100. In the case of this show, tickets typically cost between £20 and £50. We have been offered tickets at a reduced rate as we are taking part in the project and FAB has agreed to subsidise this further so that all children can see the show. This being the case, the cost to you is £4 for your child's ticket. We are very fortunate that FAB has agreed to this reduction in the cost and appreciate their contribution.
