The Job Description

To apply for the position as a digital leader, please read the information below about what the role of Digital Leader will mean.

If your application is successful, these are some of the responsibilities that you will have as part of the Digital Leader Team. These responsibilities will be shared out amongst all of the Digital Leaders.

- > Attend Digital Leader meetings, after school, at least 1x weekly.
- > Update areas of the school website or school blog site.
- > Blog on behalf of the school, a class or a club.
- > Comment on other people's blog posts.
- > Test new ICT resources, which could be websites, software or hardware.
- > Share your skills and expertise with other pupils, classes and teachers.
- > Set up ICT equipment in classrooms for teachers.
- > Support teachers and classes with ICT and computing in the classroom.
- > You may also be asked:
 - To work with children from other schools on specific projects
 - To help organise and support other out-of-school-hours activities.

In order that you can perform the above roles, we will ensure that you have the relevant training and support to perform the role.
