### Bonneville Driver: Environment

As people concerned with the environment, we will... explore how we have looked after our local environment and plant some herbs and vegetables linked to 'dig for victory'.

This topic explores how the local area has changed and developed since World War 2. Children will learn about how World War 2 started and its impact on local residents. Children will also learn about what happened to school children at Bonneville during World War 2.

### As Scientists we will...

- Discuss the difference between living and non living things.
- Look at the life cycles of different animals.

### As Artists we will...

- We will be creating designs based on World War II and learning to sew with a running stitch and cross stitch.

### As Historians we will be...

- Navigating through non-fiction texts linked to the local area.
- Following lines of enquiries and asking appropriate questions.
- Researching information and finding out about changes in the local area.

### As Home Learners you could...

- Go on a learning walk around Clapham, what can you spot?
- You might like to support your child's understanding of time by showing them how to tell the time on an analogue clock.
- Go to the local library and find information books about Clapham and the local area.
- Talk to people who have knowledge about this time, can you ask them questions and become news reporters?
