Dear Parents and Carers,

Rehearsals are well under way for Year three's Christmas play, 'A Christmas Carol' The children are very excited and keen to learn their lines, and we would be very grateful if you could support them with learning their lines and getting into character over the weekend.

In addition to this, we would ask you to kindly assist your child to gather together a couple of suitable items for their costume. Although we can provide some costumes, there are a few things we are missing that can hopefully be found at home.

The play is based in Victorian London, so the costumes cannot be too modern. Your child will know which character they are playing; if you are unsure please speak to one of us.

Your child may come to school in their costume, or change at school if this is easier.

Please bring the costumes in labeled bag, if possible.

All **narrators** should dress all in black.

The **Ghost of Marley** will need a floaty dress.

The **Ghost of Christmas Past** will need a white sheet which we will amend at school.

The **Ghost of Christmas Present** will need a Christmas jumper and covered in tinsel (festive as possible please).

The **Ghost of Christmas Yet to Come** will need a long black cloak and dressed all in black.

The **Nativity (Joseph, Mary, Shepherds, Kings, and Angel Gabriel)** characters should be dressed in black and we will provide other costumes at school.

Scrooge will also need a long dressing gown if possible.

All other characters, if you are not listed above, are to be dressed in clothes that are as old fashioned as possible. If you have anything like a suit/ suit jacket/ waistcoats/ hats/ shirts/ skirts/ dresses it would be fantastic if we could borrow them if your child is not wearing them.

We wholeheartedly appreciate any efforts you can make towards the outfits and please do not hesitate to speak to us if there are any concerns. We are looking forward to seeing you all on **Tuesday 18th December at 2pm** for the big performance.
