As people concerned with the environment, we will...

explore ways of saving energy and reducing waste



This topic explores environmental issues and how we can contribute to a greener planet. It looks at how we produce and use energy and how we can reduce our carbon footprint. Children will understand how their choices can impact the world around them and will research different forms of energy.
