**Updates to RAISEonline key stage 2 data**  
**Your school's unique reference number (URN): 131247**

We are writing to inform you that we have decided not to update RAISEonline with final 2015 key stage 2 data.

As you will know, RAISEonline currently reflects key stage 2 validated data published in the performance tables in December 2015. We have assessed the scale of change between the validated and final versions and, nationally, we found that there were only a small number of amendments that were required.

We are contacting you as your school was one of the few that did have changes to school level data. We appreciate that you will find our decision not to reflect your updated data in RAISEonline disappointing. However, given the small number of changes nationally, it was not possible to justify the cost of updating the site and completing the extensive quality assurance we apply to our datasets prior to release.

There are other ways of accessing your updated key stage 2 data. You will be able to see key measures for your school through the performance tables published by the Department for Education (DfE). These can be accessed at:

You can also use the school's own data facility to edit the pupil data within RAISEonline to see how your analyses change, and use this information in discussion with inspectors and governors.


