Welcome back to a fantastic start of the school year. It was lovely to see you all return after the summer holidays.

It has been a delight to see our children return to school in full uniform and with such a positive attitude for school and learning.

Over the course of last year, the school entered a lengthy tendering process for the school's cleaning contract and ended the contract with the previous provider at the end of the summer term. It is clear that over the course of this process the standard of cleaning significantly reduced to that of unsatisfactory. This term we entered a new contract with a new provider, who conducted a deep clean of the school over the summer.
