**Congratulations to 1T (99.6%) and 3C (99.4%) for the best attendance over the last two weeks.**

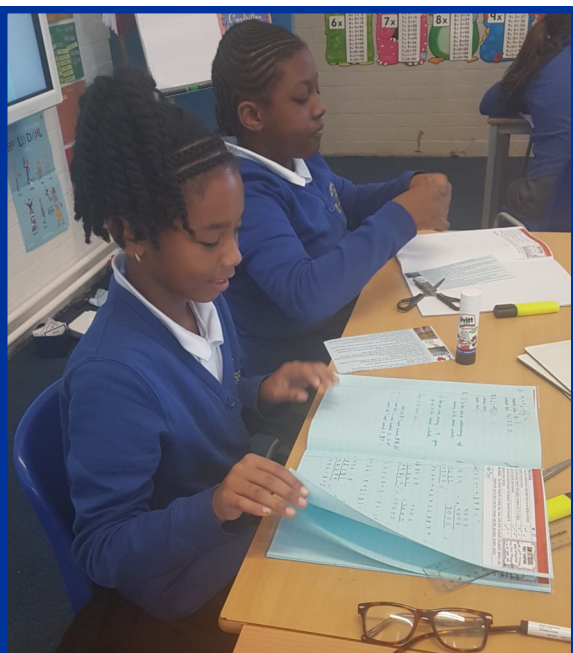
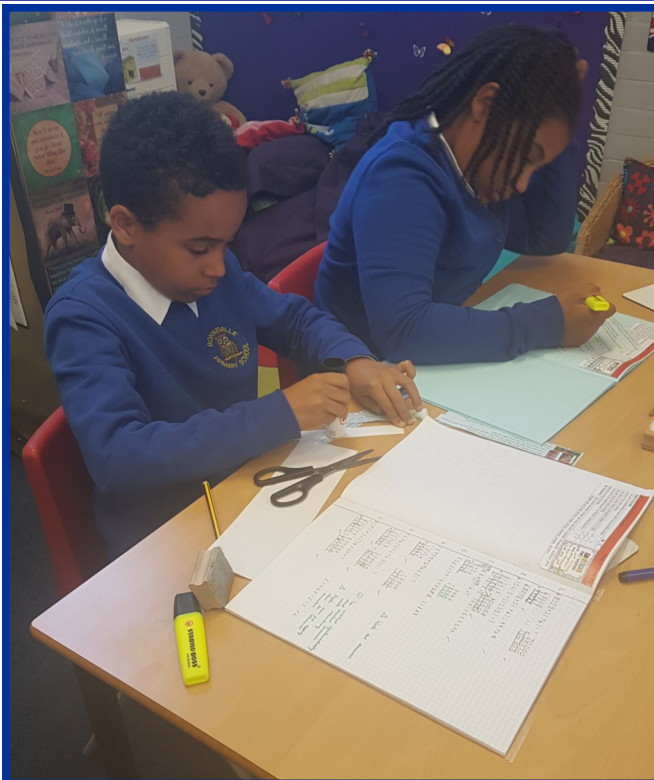
## LKS2
