Holidays During Term Time

Holidays, or trips during term time are always unauthorised.

This is because of the detrimental effect absence has on a child's ability to make academic progress and participate fully in school life.

Between 95 - 100% is an acceptable attendance rate for a child, this takes into account time for childhood illnesses. All absences below 95% will be monitored by the school's Attendance Officer and could result in intervention by the Education Welfare Officer, Social Care, penalty fines or court action.
