## Our Value this month is Understanding

### LKS2

On 21st April Year 3 will be inspired into their topic 'Plantastic' by a planting workshop with Groundworks London Projects. Then they are off on a trip to Kew Gardens on Tuesday 17th May.

This term we welcome Ricky Hobson who we hope will continue to work with us until the end of the year, when we wish to appoint a permanent member of staff for September.

### KS1

Year 2 SATs are starting, children must be in school every day, on time and well rested.

On Tuesday 3rd May, year 1 are off to the Museum of Childhood.

Children are not allowed to play with equipment (sports equipment or the climbing frame) before or after school. Parents and Carers must leave the playground straight after collecting children from school. Sitting around, having picnics or letting children play whilst you talk is not permitted. This is a moan we often have to revisit and desperately need your co-operation in this. Having to ask parents/Carers to leave is an avoidable confrontation.



**UKS2** Homework comes home on a Friday and is due in on a Wednesday. If there is a specific reason why your child has been unable to complete homework, please let his/ her class teacher know. The children are expected to complete homework assignments (including reading 5 times weekly) with adult support at home. Any child that does not complete homework as requested will have to attend homework club in Miss McIntosh's classroom during Wednesday lunchtime.

The children have recently been reminded about expectations for learning and behaviour in and around school. Please support us by reminding your children to uphold school rules.

Year 6 booster classes will resume this term, please ensure your child attends.

### Sport

Congratulation to our basketball for their huge effort and success in the Lambeth Mini Basketball Tournament. Our team made it to the final and were defeated by Granton Primary School.
