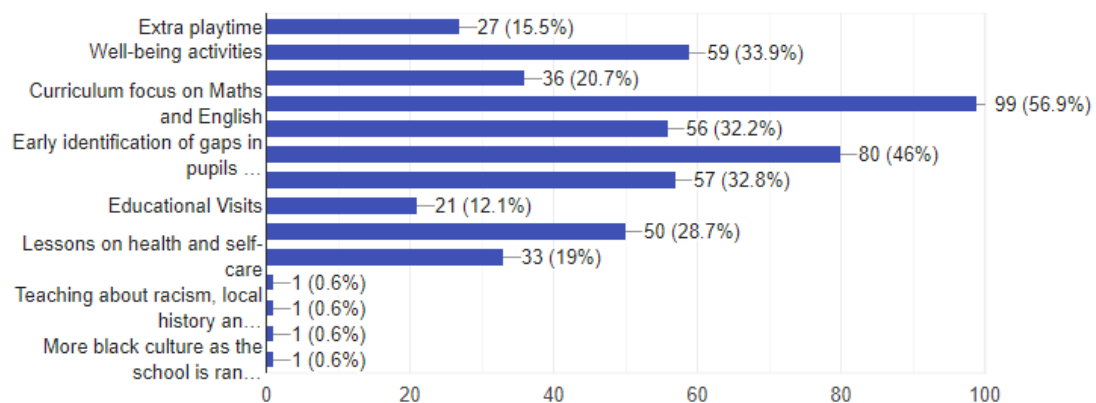

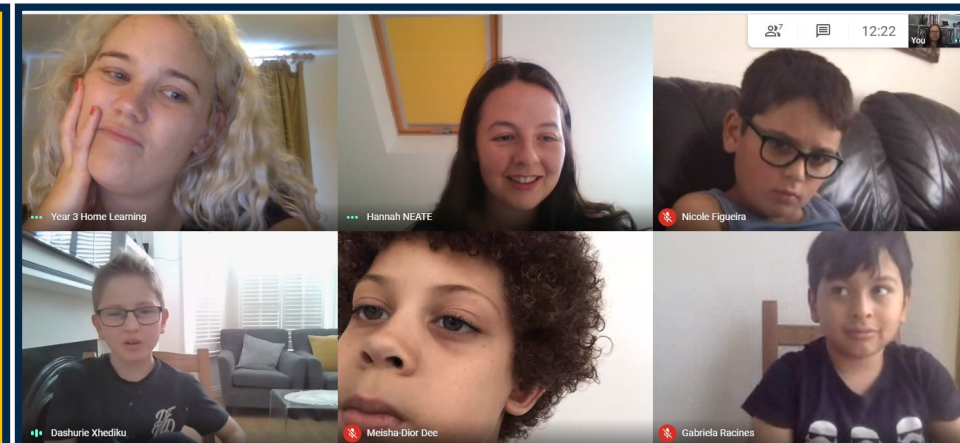
## Black Lives Matter
