Dear Parents and Carers.

Residential Visit to Ufton Court 13th - 15th January 2020

We are pleased to tell you that we have arranged a residential trip to Ufton Court in Berkshire for our Year 4 children.

The visit will take place in the week of 13th to 15th January.

We know that families will have many questions regarding the trip - particularly as it will be the first residential trip for the majority of children. I have therefore arranged some meetings to give parents more information about the trip. They will take place in the upper junior hall. These meetings will both be on Tuesday 29th October (First Tuesday after half term) before school at 9.15am and after school at 3.30pm.

The school is in the process of raising additional funds in order to reduce the final cost of the visit to families. Details of this and the final cost, will follow shortly. A reduced price can be offered to families who are in receipt of certain benefits e.g. Income Support, Incomebased Jobseekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00). guarantee element of State Pension Credit or supported under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. You will be asked to provide proof of your benefit in order to qualify for the reduced rate.

Details of costs and any questions or concerns, we can discuss at the meeting.
