I am very happy to inform you that we are fully staffed for September, with the following changes.

Sadly, we will be saying goodbye to one of our Year 2 class teachers, and our Maths Subject Leader, Miss Henderson, who has worked at the school for five years. Miss Henderson joined our school as a Newly Qualified Teacher. She very quickly developed into an inspirational practitioner, having taught classes in Key Stage One and Lower Key Stage Two. We very much appreciate her nurturing, hard work and attentiveness over the years, not to mention the incredible developments achieved with the embedding of Maths Mastery across the school. Miss Henderson is making a timely move from Bonneville, in order to fulfil her upcoming plans to move home.

Miss Ingham, a Key Stage Two class teacher and our English Subject Leader, has been a member of our staff team for six years. Miss Ingham began her professional journey at Bonneville as a student teacher who, very early on, stood out as an exceptional practitioner, developing her practice, teaching in Key Stage One, Lower Key Stage Two and Upper Key Stage Two. Miss Ingham's contribution to whole school improvement has resulted in the embedding of our teaching vocabulary strategy, and the cyclical approach to genre coverage in our English writing curriculum. We are truly grateful for her dedication and commitment to supporting whole school improvements.

We are incredibly proud that Miss Ingham has secured a promotion, as Special Educational Needs Coordinator, at a school in the Lewisham borough.

Miss Griffiths has worked at Bonneville for two years as a Year 6 class teacher, supporting two cohorts of children through SATs, the last stage of their primary education, and transition to secondary school. Having settled in very quickly, Miss Griffiths has worked incredibly hard to ensure our children are well cared for, going the extra mile to ensure they are well prepared for the next stage in their lives.
