Ms Parker's tips!

Set up

- If you already use our online system for payments (school dinners, extended services and last year parent consultation), you're already set up to make an appointment
- If you have not used our system (Tucasi- scopay), you need to use your login, previously provided, and register your account to make an appointment
- I recommend that you switch on your alerts within the system so you can receive a reminder of your appointment

Booking

- In your area you will be able to see the available appointments for your child's/ren's teacher. If you have more than one child, stagger your appointments accordingly, to reduce waiting time
- If you need any advice or assistance please contact the school office

The purpose of the consultation is to find out from you, how your child/ren has coped physical, mentally, emotionally and academically, so we can plan to support their needs going forward. If your child/dren has not struggled, we would still love to speak with you. We could gain further insight into how best your child learns and build on this.
