## Did you know?...

- -Did you know that year groups do not mix. This includes during playtimes and use of equipment
- -Did you know that staff members are also allocated to year group bubbles, and do not mix with each other or any other year group
- -Did you know that only key staff members are allocated to supervise year groups from a 2 metre distance
- -Did you know that although we are all onsite, staff meetings are still delivered virtually to reduce viral load and transmission risk
- -Did you know that we are creating an environment that significantly reduces chance of the virus incubating in our school. We do this by regularly cleaning and cleansing surfaces, equipment and our hands
- -Did you know that only six staff members are allowed in our staffroom at any one time
- -Did you know that children have lunch in their year groups bubbles in a designated space allocated to them, every single day
- -Did you know our enrichment clubs, Reading Café and Carry on Café are also delivered in year groups areas
- -Did you know that the keypad on the photocopiers get sanitised
- -Did you know the lower transmission rates are child to child
- -Did you know that isolation advice can be different, depending on the circumstances of each individual case
