Virtual Parent consultations are fast approaching and we would like to maximize the time you have to book your appointment online.

The booking system will be live from **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November at 7am**. As usual, all appointments are available on a first come first serve basis.

**Nursery: Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup>, Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> between 3pm and 5pm**

**Reception to Year 6: Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> between 3pm and 7pm, Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> between 3pm and 6pm**

### Ms Parker's tips!

#### Set up

- If you already use our online system for payments (school dinners, extended services and last year parent consultation), you are already set up to make an appointment
- If you have not used our system (Tucasi- scopay), you need to use your login, previously provided, and register your account to make an appointment
- I recommend that you switch on your alerts within the system so you can receive a reminder of your appointment

#### Booking

- In your area you will be able to see the available appointments for your child's/ren's teacher. If you have more than one child, stagger your appointments accordingly, to reduce waiting time
- If you need any advice or assistance please contact the school office

The purpose of the consultation is to find out from you, how your child/ren has coped physical, mentally, emotionally and academically, so we can plan to support their needs going forward. If your child/dren has not struggled, we would still love to speak with you. We could gain further insight into how best your child learns and build on this.

It is vitally important that we get the opportunity to discuss all this with you; therefore, we are fully committed to securing an appointment for every single child.

We ask that you help us to achieve this by confirming an appointment over the three-day period.

Children do best when school and parents work together; we all want the best and have the right intentions for our children.
