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Safeguarding

It has been brought to our attention that there appears to be a new trend emerging on TikTok. Some TikTok users are advertising for students to give them their remote learning login details so that they can disrupt lessons. They film the disruption and post it on Tiktok with tags similar to #lockoff.

Whilst we are all using the Internet more regularly, we advise that you reinforce the message to our children that they must keep their passwords private and that giving out their details can lead to fraud and other criminality.

Please stress the importance of our 'lockdown' signal '**Traffic Light, Traffic Light, Traffic Light**' with your child/ren. This will be used by class teachers to instruct children to leave the live session immediately, should they observe an online safety risk to our children.
