Dear Parents/Carers,

Further to my correspondence last week, I am writing to update you regarding the Nursery provision. As part of our ongoing review of the potential to extend Nursery places, beyond that of vulnerable and Key Worker children, a risk assessment has been conducted and a thorough review of the school's staffing capacity has been done. In light of completing both of these processes, it is clear that the school is currently already under immense pressure to operate the Nursery provision further.

Whilst we are keen to support the National effort, additional strain on the current provision would make our efforts counterproductive if extending our offer, if our Bubbles become too large against our risk assessment. However, in a bid to explore the possibility of opening our Nursery on a limited basis, we would like your feedback as to what extent you are in extreme need of the provision. For this reason, we would like you to make a selection on our survey, to help us better understand the needs of our Nursery community. The options are:

- Full Day- on selected day(s) of the week (9am to 3.15pm)
- Part Time (am)- on selected day(s) of the week (9am to 12pm)
- Part Time (pm)- on selected day(s) of the week (12pm to 3.15pm)

Please keep in mind that we are only investigating the potential of extending the provision at this stage and we would urge parents and carers to continue to home school their child, given the associated risks of bringing them onsite.

If you can work with us to limit your choices, leading to a reduced number of children, we can risk assess this information.
