# At the Seaside

This term we will be learning all about the history and geography of coastal/seaside/beach resorts and locations from the Victorian era to the present day. Here are some ideas to inspire you but don't feel limited to these!

## Home Activities:

1. Create a sea creature from recycled materials (you could research the impact of plastic pollution!)
2. Create an advertisement poster for a present day or past seaside resort. Think about what is appealing about a seaside destination.
3. Build a seaside structure from different materials e.g. a beach hut or lighthouse.
4. Paint/draw/collage/create a seaside scene.
5. Design an outfit you might wear at the beach.
6. Write a list of things you might take to the beach. How could you keep safe at the beach?
7. Design or make a healthy picnic to take to the beach. What food could you make? Could you create a seaside themed plate of food for a treat? See the pictures below for inspiration.
8. You could set up a seaside café and work out how to pay for different items on the menu using coins.
9. Visit your local library and read/borrow books about the seaside.
10. Create a fact file about a seaside location or sea creature.
11. Write a postcard from a seaside resort – think about what you could do there and what you might see, hear, smell, taste and feel?
12. Write a story about something you find on the beach (a washed up creature, a magic shell...)
13. Create a Punch and Judy puppet theatre.
14. Make repeating patterns with shells.
15. Learn or play a song about the seaside.
16. Create a video/poster/fact file/leaflet about ways of looking after the beach environment for other people to enjoy.
