Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for attending the English Workshop last Thursday. As part of the workshop, I spoke about Reading at Bonneville and the expectations.

Children in Years 5 and 6 should be reading independently for at least 20 minutes every day and recording in their reading journals. As a parent, we expect you to read with your child at least once a week, and then talk/ask questions about what they have read and sign or make a comment also in their reading journal.

During the workshop, I spoke about the class teacher reading a class story at the end of the school day. This is an opportunity for children to listen to stories from different genres, be introduced to the related vocabulary to that genre and a time to just relax and immerse themselves into a fictional world. A parent requested a copy of the different books that will be read at the end of the day so I have attached a copy to this letter.
