# **RE: Year 6 Trips and Activities**

#### <u>Kidzania (7<sup>th</sup> June 2022)</u>

On Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June, your child has been invited to Kidzania. We will be visiting this venue as part of a series of reward trips for completing S.A.T's (and because they did not get to go last year). We will be leaving school at 9.00am and shall return by 3:30pm. The children will need a packed lunch for the day. Drinks should be in a juice box or a plastic bottle that will not leak. No glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch please indicate via scopay by selecting 'PL KID'.

#### Blacklands Farm (Residential, 6th-8th July 2022)

On Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July- Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July, your child has been invited to attend a residential trip to Blacklands farm.

The children will take part in adult led sessions including activities such as: kayaking, abseiling, zip-wire and orienteering. We leave school on Wednesday shortly after registration and will return on Friday at approximately 4pm. Further details about the week will be shared as we approach the departure date. The children will be staying in dormentries- boys and girls sleeping separately. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for.

On the day, your child will be allowed to bring spending money (to Chessington only) they will need to be responsible for it so please ensure the money is in a suitable, safe wallet or purse. This is not essential but if you want to send your child to school with some spending money the maximum amount is £10.00.

The full cost of the trip will be **£180**. A reduced price of  $\pounds$ 100 can be offered to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00)
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit;
- an income related employment and support allowance

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to speak to one of the admin team.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to speak with Florence Kirk as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties.

In order to reserve your child's place on this year's residential we now require a deposit of £50 per child (£20 if you believe that you qualify for the reduced rate and are going to supply documentation to this effect). This should be paid via Scopay by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May**.

To make payment please login into you Scopay account and click the trip tab '**Y6 Trips** which you will find on the scopay home page. You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. The total cost will be due on **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June**.

Please note, any child with an outstanding balance of more than £50 on the morning of the trip will be unable to take part. At this time, payments will have been made to external companies, so no refunds will be possible. Please ensure that you are able to pay the balance in full and on time so that your child can take part. If you are concerned that this will not be possible, please meet with Miss Kirk to make arrangements for the payment of the trip.
