Last week the Local Authority conducted a review of our 'Quality of Provision'. We are pleased to share this was a huge success, comments from the report include:

'The intent, for children to read well and learn to read as quickly as possible is proving highly successful in its implementation. Phonics teaching is a significant strength'.

'Children told me that there is always an adult they can speak to if they need to, that new children are welcomed through friendships and buddies. They told me that at Bonneville, 'you can always find a friend'.

The lead up to Winter festivities is always a busy time. Class assemblies have begun, FAB have started their winter themed events, KS1 and EYFS prepare for their Nativity plays, and we eat together for Christmas lunch to mention just a few. 



(email via the admin team to request a meeting)

#### 2) You may contact the leader of your child's phase (see above)

This includes issues regarding communication and organisation

(email via the admin team to request a meeting)

Should you be dissatisfied with the handling or outcome...

#### 3) You may raise your concerns with Ms Parker

(email via the admin team to request a meeting outlining the nature for the purpose of the meeting)

Leaders are required to share items (as appropriate) with Ms Parker on a weekly basis, even if the matter is being handled by them.

We request that you do not field your concerns to FAB but instead work directly with the school staff as outlined above.
