RE: Industrial Action by the National Education Union - <u>Thursday 27th April 2023 & Tuesday 2nd May 2023</u>

On 3rd April the National Education Union (NEU), one of the trade unions representing the teaching profession, announced its intention to continue striking as the offer was rejected. The NEU has said it will hold strikes on:

- Thursday, 27 April (England and Wales)
- Tuesday, 2nd May (England and Wales)

Following consultation with the teachers, I can confirm that the school will remain open for the following classes only
