Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Year 4!

We hope that your children will settle well into Year 4. Year 4 is a wonderful year where the children are able to apply all of their knowledge from Year 3 to continue developing their understanding.

School Uniform

It is expected that your child will wear the correct uniform every day, including dark shoes. Please make sure **each piece is named**, as often items of clothing go missing or get lost!

Bags

Children are expected to bring a bag to school each day. This should contain: a named water bottle, their reading book and their reading record.

P.E

Please make sure your child has his/her named full kit at school at all times apart from weekends when it can be washed. Full PE kit consists of; shorts/jogging bottoms in colour's white, blue, grey or black, a white t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers. No jewellery or watches are allowed apart from earring studs.

Start and end of the Day.

School begins at 9am and ends at 3.15pm. The gates will be open from 8:45-9:00am for the children to enter. Children will enter and leave from the big black gate, as they have done during year 3. For health and safety reasons, your child needs to stay with the teacher until he/she is collected. Children who are not collected by 3.25pm will be taken to the office. Please remember, if your child is going to be picked up by someone new, you need to let the office know. You need to use a password that the teacher will be told and the person picking up will be told. This is for safety reasons and we cannot let children go with new adults without passwords or prior knowledge as to who is picking up.

Topic for the Autumn term

Our topic in the Autumn term is Rotten Romans, focusing on the Romanisation of Britain! If you want to, you may like to do some research about these topics during the holidays.

Homework

The children will be receiving weekly spellings homework on **Google Classroom**, as well as a bi-weekly task on **MyMaths** and a bi-weekly maths task in their maths homework book. Homework is set every Friday and is expected to be completed by the following Wednesday. The children will all receive topic homework to be completed over the duration of each term. One piece of topic homework will be due towards the end of every half term.
