Dear Parent/Carer

We are pleased to say that your children have all made a really positive start in their new reception class.

I would just like to take the opportunity to pass on some useful messages:

1. We have noticed that many children are bringing snacks into school. Children are given fruit each morning at playtime, so should NOT bring in additional snacks. The only time this would be necessary would be if they are taking part in one of our after school clubs.
2. Children should bring a filled and named water bottle to school each day. You might also like to add some spare clothing into their bag in case of accidents or particularly enthusiastic play in our water tray!
3. All items of clothing should be clearly named and we recommend also naming bicycle helmets and scooters.
4. Books from the class library will start being sent home next week. This is a book that your child has chosen to share with you. Please share this book at home and support us in our aim for all children to love reading.
