## What is FAB?

A volunteer group and registered charity made up of parents, carers and friends of the school. It is a **Friends Association** and not a Parent Teachers Association.

Our **purpose is to raise money**, money which is used to benefit every child within the school. Examples include: contributing towards the cost of school trips, buying reading books and funding new playground equipment.

All events are created, managed and **run by volunteers** from FAB and the children of Bonneville.

## Easy ways to fundraise

**'Easyfundraising'** – is a fabulous organisation that allows you to raise funds every time you shop online. **easyfundraising.org.uk** donates a percentage of your spend value from over 7,000 e-commerce sites to FAB. Go to [easyfundraising.org.uk](https://easyfundraising.org.uk) to setup on any device. Last year we raised over £600 through easyfundraising. In the past 30 days we have recruited 2 new supporters and raised £78.29!

**Employer donations** – if you work for an organisation, large or small, as part of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) charter they may either volunteer or corporate matching; where they match either the hours you volunteer or the funds raised. Last year, we raised over £1,000 through employer donations.
