## Homework in Upper Key Stage 2

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has come to my attention that there are a fair number of children who are not completing all the homework tasks set each week. This is a reminder of the homework tasks and the expectations.

Subject	Given out by the teacher	Completed and returned by the pupil
<b>Maths</b> either: TT Rockstars or Maths in book	Friday	Wednesday
<b>Spellings</b> Includes writing a sentence (10 in all) that includes the spelling word	Friday	Wednesday
<b>Topic/Science</b> (x1 each term)	Set at the beginning of term	By the end of the term
<b>Reading</b> Children to read every day for at least 20 minutes and record in reading journals	Ongoing	Teachers will check reading journals weekly.

Children who have difficulties in completing tasks will attend a 'Homework Club' at lunchtimes. Homework is expected to be presented in a neat and organised way and guidance on this is given in the front cover of each homework book.

The purpose of homework is to develop effective partnerships in children's learning between home and school; consolidate and reinforce skills and understanding; extend school learning to develop a creative, learning culture/ethos; encourage older pupils to be self-motivated and disciplined in their study. Homework tasks are planned for alongside weekly planning to ensure that there is progression in learning.
