Year 4 Residential Visit to Ufton Court

Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you to those of you who came to the meeting earlier this month on Ufton Court. I can now confirm the final details for the Year 4 Residential Visit to Ufton Court that will take place **Wednesday 15th January until Friday 17th January 2025**. We leave school on Wednesday 15th January around 9am and will return on Friday 17th January at approximately 3.30pm.

Our trip to Ufton Court is an exciting way to further deepen the children's curriculum learning for their Autumn Term's topic, "Rotten Romans". During the visit, the pupils will be staying in a Manor House, with boys and girls sleeping separately. The supervising adults will be close by having a room within the house. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for. The children will take part in a range of enjoyable and hands-on sessions every day in line with their Roman topic.

I am pleased to share that I have successfully applied for and been awarded two grants, which will cover the cost of Ufton Court (excluding the cost of coach travel) for those children of families that qualify. A huge thank you to Ufton Court themselves who have awarded us a 50% bursary towards the final cost, and another huge thank you to the Wolcott Foundation who have also awarded us a 50% charitable donation.

The price of the trip will be **£210** with a further reduced price of **£30** offered to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £19,995)
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- An income related employment and support allowance.

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to talk with the school office so that we can apply the reduced cost to you. If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to see myself (Miss Napier) or either of the class teachers (Miss Neate or Miss Ford) as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties.

In order to reserve your child's place on this year's residential we now require a deposit of **£30 per child**. This should be paid via Weduc by **Monday 11th November 2024**. You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. The total cost will be due on **Friday 6th December 2024**. Please note that if an insufficient number of parents make payments, the trip will not be able to go ahead.

Further information will be sent out shortly regarding what the children will need to bring with them and requests for medical and dietary needs. However, if you have any further questions please don't hesitate to ask myself, Miss Neate or Miss Ford. We are all looking forward to going in January.
