Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Year 6 Residential Trip – PGL- Monday 3rd March 2025 to Friday 7th March 2025

On Monday 3rd March to Friday 7th March 2025, your child has been invited to attend a residential trip to PGL activity centre where they will take part in adult led sessions including activities such as: archery, zip-wiring and orienteering.

We leave school on Monday shortly after registration and will return on Friday at approximately 3:30pm. Further details about the week will be shared as we approach the departure date.

The children will be staying in dormitories- boys and girls sleeping separately. All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for.

The full cost of the trip will be **£350** and a reduced price of **£197** can be offered to families who are in receipt of the any of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £16,190.00)
- the guarantee element of State Pension Credit;
- an income related employment and support allowance

If you believe that any of the above applies to you, please make arrangements to speak to one of the admin team.

If you are NOT in receipt of any of the above benefits, but may have difficulty meeting the cost of the trip, please arrange to speak with Florence Kirk as we would not want any child to miss out on the chance to take part due to financial difficulties.

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In order to reserve your child's place on this year's residential we now require a deposit of £30 per child. This should be paid via Weduc by Monday 27th January 2025.

You are welcome to pay in full at any time, or we are happy to accept instalments towards the final cost. If you are paying the full cost of £350 and you want to opt to pay over six weeks, you will need to pay £583.33 per week OR over 11 weeks, £29.09. If you are paying the reduced cost of £197, over six weeks the cost will be £27.83 OR over eleven weeks £15.18. The total cost will be due on by Friday 28th February 2025. All payments need to be paid online via Weduc.

Please note, any child with an outstanding balance of more than £50 on the morning of the trip will be unable to take part. At this time, payments will have been made to external companies, so no refunds will be possible. Please ensure that you are able to pay the balance in full and on time so that your child can take part. If you are concerned that this will not be possible, please meet with Miss Kirk to make arrangements for the payment of the trip.

We know that families will have many questions regarding the trip so I would therefore like to invite you to a virtual meeting on **Thursday 23rd January at 5:00pm**. At this time, you will have the opportunity to find out more about the site, accommodation, itinerary for the week, ask questions and discuss any concerns.
