We are due to **return to school between 3:30pm and 4.00pm**, traffic dependent. Please make sure that your children come to school in their school uniform with appropriate footwear and that they have water, sun cream, a sun hat, a small towel all in a bag they can easily carry. Please **do not** give your child money to spend.

The cost of the visit is £20; this has kindly been subsidised by FAB. Please pay for the visit via Weduc >> Parent Pay as well as any packed lunches if required. As always, we need adult support on the visit but we are limited to the number of adults we can take due to spaces on the coach. If you are able to come with us, please let your class teacher know using Weduc>> Parent Pay and we will inform you if your help is required. Please note that siblings will not be allowed to accompany parent helpers on the visit as all parent helpers will be expected to remain with and support their group throughout the day. Please do not travel down to Brighton to join us on this visit as this presents a risk that we have not planned for on our risk assessment.
