Ufton Court Meeting

Dear Parents / Carers,

As I previously shared with you, I am pleased to announce that we have successfully booked our Year 4 residential trip to Ufton Court from **Wednesday 3rd December to Friday 5th December 2025**.

We will be holding a meeting for all Year 4 parents / carers to talk through our residential trip and answer any questions you may have. To try and cater for as many as possible, we will hold one meeting on **Monday 22nd September at 9.00am in (Y6 Additional Room)**, and one on **Tuesday 23rd September at 3.30pm (4N Classroom)**- you only need to attend one.

Our trip to Ufton Court is an exciting way to further deepen the children's curriculum learning for their Autumn Term's topic, "Rotten Romans". All food will be provided for the duration of the visit and dietary requirements can be catered for. The children will take part in a range of enjoyable and hands-on sessions every day in line with their Roman topic. Both Year 4 teachers – Miss Neate and Miss Ford - will be attending as well as other Bonneville staff members, and I excited to announce that this year will be going as a wider Federation being in attendance with Stockwell Primary for the entirety of the trip, and crossing over for one day with Jessop Primary.

I am pleased to share that we have secured a bursary from Ufton Court themselves who have awarded us a 50% reduction towards the final cost (excluding coach). I will be applying for a further grant to hopefully receive another charitable donation, which will allow our families in receipt of the any of the following benefits to a further reduced cost:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (without Working Tax Credit and an income of no more than £19,995)
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- An income related employment and support allowance.

All other relevant information and costings will be shared at the meeting.
