IntoUniversity Workshops – 6H

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on to my letter regarding the exciting project that we are doing with *IntoUniversity*, I would like to share a few more details. On **Monday 9th to Friday 13th February**, 6H will be having a week-long series of immersive workshops, and together with the *IntoUniversity* team, we have chosen an exciting theme of *Engineering* for the week. This will be supported by interactive, immersive and hands-on workshops, which are designed to spark curiosity and ambition, an engineering linked off-site visit to the Design Museum, and a graduation ceremony at a university. A special highlight of the week will be the Friday visit to a real university campus. Here, students will explore university life, take part in activities in an authentic academic setting, and celebrate their achievements with a graduation ceremony - an unforgettable experience that helps children imagine the possibilities ahead on Friday 13th February 2026 at St Mary's University, Twickenham.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and will return by 3:15pm each day. We will be walking as well as travelling by Transport for London. The children will need a packed lunch - drinks should be in a container that will not leak and no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, please indicate this on Weduc. Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the trip - the children should wear full Bonneville School Uniform including dark footwear and they should also bring along a warm, waterproof coat in case of bad weather.

Please can you give permission for your child to attend via Weduc and state whether you would like them to have a school packed lunch for the week. In addition to this, *IntoUniversity* also have their own form registration form that needs to be completed and returned to us. Can these all be completed by **Thursday 5th February**.
