- Siblings are not permitted to accompany parent helpers on the visit.
- Parents should not travel independently to Brighton to join the trip, as this would present safeguarding and risk assessment concerns that have not been planned for as part of the visit.

If your child is prone to travel sickness, please inform your child's class teacher in advance and ensure that any necessary medication is administered before the journey, in accordance with school procedures.
